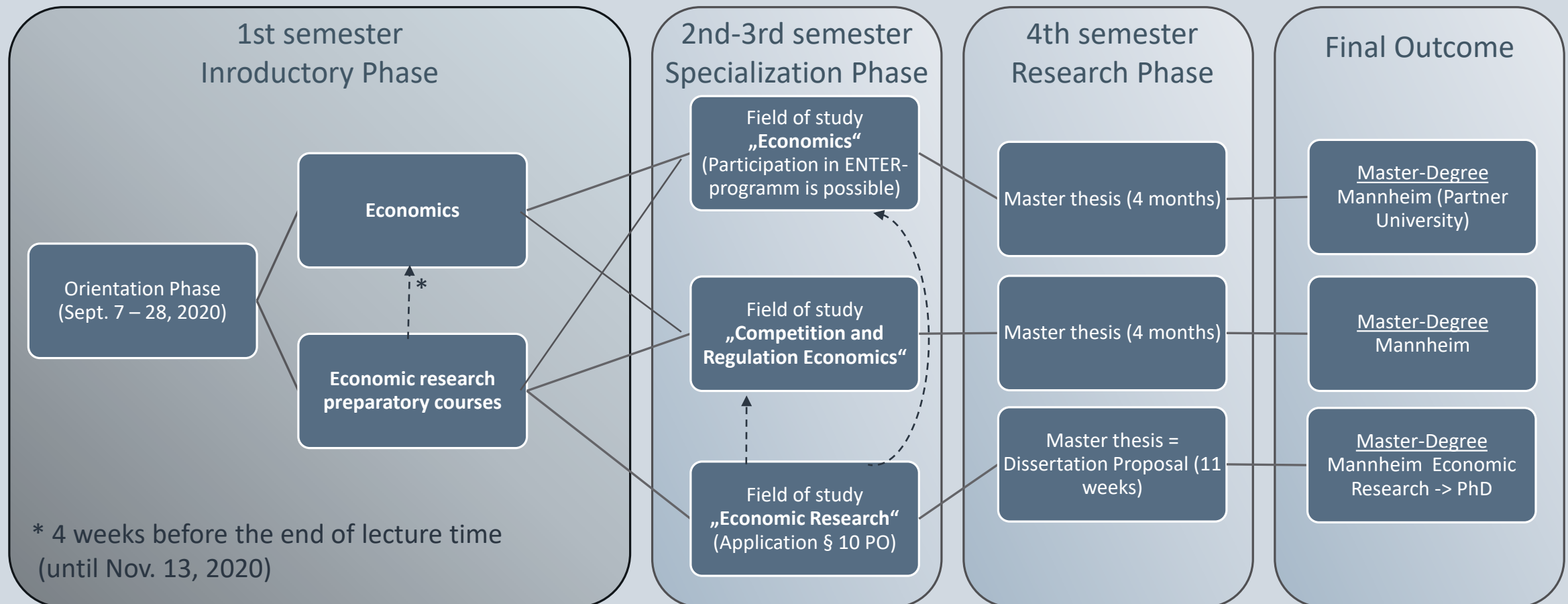

- E603 Advanced Econometrics (10 ECTS credits)

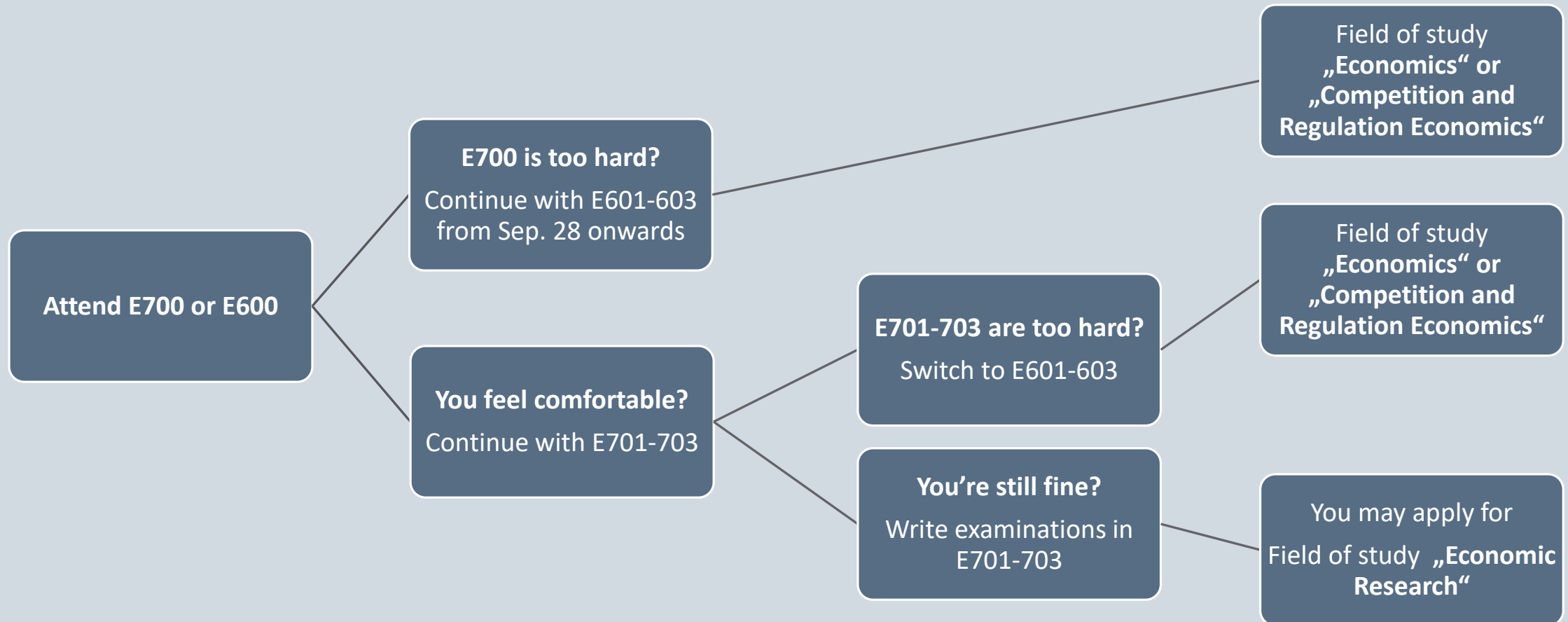
Specialization phase (2nd - 3rd Semester)
