

How to request a letter of recommendation for your application to a Master's program

A letter of recommendation is a vital part of your application. Therefore, please carefully read the following information which you may find quite useful.

Prerequisites:

The below grades are to be interpreted as reference values.

- Successful completion of the lecture "Finanzwissenschaft" with a grade of 2.0 or higher
- 2. An average grade of 2.5 of the mandatory courses of the bachelor's program
- 3. Student must be personally known, e.g. through completion of an elective course on public finance (good or very good grading), in order to be able to write a significant letter of recommendation.

Meeting the requirements does not imply the right to obtain a letter of recommendation. Please contact Professor Janeba via <u>email</u> in order to discuss further steps. For reasons of capacity, the number of applications is limited to 10. The letter is *always* sent directly to the respective institution.

Documentation:

If you are promised a letter of recommendation, please submit the documents listed below one month prior to the first application deadline at the latest:

- 1. preliminary list of institutions
- 2. transcript of records with ranking
- 3. CV
- 4. short letter of motivation (it is also possible to talk about your motivation during an individual meeting)
